- A. <u>Animal Control Ordinance</u> Ordinance #802 was adopted on Nov. 14, 2022 after 6 months of working to determine the best way to combine all six ordinances that contain animal control rules and Regs regarding dogs and cats. The council discussed Ordinance numbers 400, 496, 551, 557, 679, 789, and 802. The council discussed the different fees and the insurance that is required in Ordinance 802. The council decided to go ahead and send the questionnaire out in the water bill for citizens to voice their opinions.
