CITY OF LONOKE CITY COUNCIL WORKING SESSION MINUTES June 17, 2021

The Lonoke City Council held a working session in the council room on June 17, 2021 at 6:15 p.m. following a special called council meeting. Two items were on the agenda for the meeting:

- A. DRAINAGE STUDY PROGRESS REPORT BY MCCLELLAND ENGINEERS Jay Whisker and Aaron Petty of McClelland Consulting Engineers, Inc. to give the city council a report as to exactly what steps will occur in the drainage study and where they are to date. Both men gave reports and answered questions on the actual scope of work being conducted and gave an approximate timeframe as to when the study would be completed and in report form. This was said to be by years end. The final report will contain recommendations on how to best remedy any of the issues discovered throughout the city during the study.
- B. WATCHGUARD BODY & AUTO CAMERA PRESENTATION Matthew Warren of Watchguard (a division of Motorola Solutions) made a presentation to show the council the benefits of their integrated V300 body camera and 4RE car camera system and the reasons why police departments are switching to this technology. "Record after the Fact" is patented technology provided only by their body cameras that would allow the officer/department to go back in time and retrieve footage if a camera didn't get turned on for any reason, or was needed to see if it picked up something that might have occurred on patrol. Matthew presented two proposals. One was the purchase price through Sourcewell with the server on premises for \$162,556.55 that can be financed at 0% interest for 5 years through Motorola. The other was a purchase with cloud storage offsite through Sourcewell for \$158,821.65 that can be financed for 0% interest through Motorola as well. He answered many questions and had a unit set up outside in his vehicle for the council members to view.
