PUBLIC NOTICE

The Lonoke Waterworks is a public water system subject to regulation under the federal Safe Drinking Water Act. Those regulations require the notification of customers whenever a violation occurs, and is the basis for this notice.

Distribution system disinfectant chlorine residual must be monitored at the same time and place as when bacteriological compliance samples are collected. Either the residuals were not measured or the form documenting the residuals was not submitted to the ADH Engineering Section for the period of March 2019.

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency sets national standards for drinking water. Part of those regulations sets limits on the level of disinfectant which is allowed in the distribution system. Failure to meet this requirement does not mean that the water is unsafe of that alternate sources of water should be used.

The water system has <u>reviewed our Bacti Sampling procedure and will ensure that all data will be recorded during the</u> <u>sampling process in the future.</u>
